

Are you a Boeing or Microsoft Employee?

Be sure to maximize your donations this year by utilizing the donation programs offered by your companies. Get credit for your TIME and Money while helping your school.

Microsoft “GIVE”

Employees simply log your donations through Microsoft’s internal “give” website. Employees have up to one year to submit for matching funds.. Microsoft processes payouts to eligible non-profit organizations on a quarterly basis.

Microsoft will match employee cash or Microsoft product donations to all eligible U.S. based nonprofit organizations and educational institutions with a U.S. Department of Treasury 501(c)(3) public charity status, up to \$12,000 per employee, per year. Additionally, when employees volunteer at least 10 hours in the community, Microsoft will donate \$17 per hour to the eligible organizations they serve. In 2009 alone, Microsoft matched over 340,000 volunteer hours, resulting in donations of over \$5.8 million to thousands of 501(c)(3) charitable organizations and educational institutions across the U.S.

Boeing Gift Match

Boeing offers generous matching programs for eligible employees to increase their positive community impact through charitable donations, volunteer hours and participation in fundraising walks. The match programs can be used alone or in combination for a maximum match of \$6,000 per employee per year to eligible organizations. The programs are administered through TotalAccess, My Community Giving.

Monetary Gift Match

Your charitable donation can be doubled by requesting a Boeing monetary gift match. Boeing offers employees a 1:1 match for personal donations of cash or stock to eligible charitable organizations (retirees receive a 0.5:1 match). The minimum gift amount per organization is \$25.

Volunteer Hours Match

The hours you spend donating time and skills to non-profits can also be matched with dollars, giving an added benefit for your favorite community organization. For every 25 hours of volunteer service you give to an approved organization, Boeing will donate \$250 to that organization.
