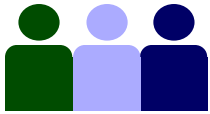
Making the System Work

May 21, 2011 – 10:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

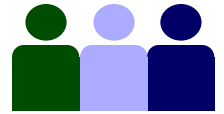
